Meeting called to order at 11:04 a.m.

DJ Scallorn reported that the Community Resources have been posted on the City of Moscow website on the Poverty on the Palouse page and as a direct link under the main Residents menu. The Resources are listed alphabetically; include a website link if available; contacts; and a short description. Scallorn said if there are any Resources missing from the list they can be added by emailing her the details.

Jessica Brierly updated the group on the Facebook page. The page draft is developing and additional information will be added in the next few weeks. Discussion ensued regarding including links in the about section. The consensus was to have the Facebook update on a future agenda.

Brierly asked the group about developing a logo. Discussion ensued regarding how to release a call for art for a volunteer to design a logo and what the logo should include (dwelling on the rolling hills; growing food; harvest; a reflection of the Palouse and not just Moscow, ID; involving the community/people; and including the text Poverty on the Palouse). The consensus was to have Scallorn and Jen Pfiffner meet to review calls for art and report back to the group.

Discussion ensued regarding if the group should be created as a non-profit (decision was due to expense to wait until the group is more developed); a reminder of the League of Women Voters meeting Wednesday, October 24, 2018 in the Arts Room at the 1912 Center; and Brierly is following up with Palouse Table.

Upcoming Agenda items include a Support Group Updates; Jen Pfiffner will report on the group's Issue Statements; General Announcements/Updates; an update on the Facebook; and an update on the call for a logo design.
