

MOUNTAIN VIEW ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

GOAL: Improve traffic flow and enhance safety on Mountain View Road and in the surrounding area.

IMPROVEMENTS:

- Widening the roadway from 24 feet to 36 feet between Joseph Street and East Sixth Street.
- Constructing a new roundabout at the Mountain View Road/ East Sixth Street intersection.
- Adding left-turn bays at the Mountain View Road/Joseph Street intersection.
- Enhancing storm drains and lighting.
- Building bike lanes, curb, gutter and sidewalks along Mountain View Road.

ROUNDABOUTS 101:

Benefits of a roundabout:

- Slows all traffic and reduces stops.
- Safest type of at-grade intersection.
- Accommodate daily changes in directional volumes.

Studies by the Insurance Institute for Highway Safety show that roundabouts improve safety at similar intersections:

- 90% reduction in fatal crashes.
- 76% reduction in injury crashes.
- 30-40% reduction in pedestrian crashes.
- 10% reduction in bicycle crashes.

SCHEDULE: 2018 **2018** – Secured funding for final design. **Sept. 2018** – Kicked off final design phase. 2019 -Oct. 2018 - Hosted public open house and stakeholder interviews. 2020 2021 -
