

## INTERMODAL TRANSIT CENTER

### **Description:**

The Intermodal Transit Center is the result of a \$1.5 million Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER II) grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation. The facility is designed to feature exterior covered structures with a foot passenger loading zone and secure parking for buses and bicycles.

## **History:**

2012:

- Using TIGER II grant funds, the City constructed the Intermodal Transit Center, which is on University of Idaho property. As part of the agreement, the City owns and maintains the facility for a bus station, and the University of Idaho occupies a portion of the facility for its parking services department. The City Parks and Recreation Department maintains the facility.
- June – Construction began on the facility.
- November – Construction was finished and the certificate of occupancy was completed.

2018:

- Exterior concrete was replaced surrounding the building.
