Southview Avenue across from the Grove Apartments

4.09 Acres (Undeveloped)



Description:

This 4-acre site is an agricultural field along Southview Avenue, across from The Grove apartment complex. The current vision for the park includes an area that has a mix of fruit and nut trees, as well as berry bushes, vines, herbs and other edible plants; all available for some level of public foraging. Harvest Park is a long term, dynamic landscape. This unique space is intended to provide educational opportunities and an example to our community of stewardship of a public food forest. It will create a sense of community pride for the City of Moscow for generations to come.

History:

2008:

- Indian Hills 8th Property: 1.73 acres of farmland property was obtained by the City through parkland dedication requirements for the Indian Hills 8th Addition subdivision.



Indian Hills 8th Park Property

2018:

- Indian Hills 8th Park property was traded by Indian Hills Trading Company for 4.07 acres which is now Harvest Park.
- Plans for the new edible forest park began moving forward.
- November 6th - Following the park naming nomination period which ran from September 12, 2018 to October 20, 2018, the Moscow Tree Commission recommended the name “Harvest Park” as the official name of the park.
- December 19th - The first public planning workshop for the park was held.
