

INDIAN HILLS PARK

1830 South Blaine Street

1.2 Acres



Description:

One of Moscow's newest parks, Indian Hills Park features two play structures- one of which is designed specifically for 2-5 year olds and another for 5-12 year olds. The park also has safety surfacing and an accessible pathway to the playground.



Amenities:

- Play structure (2-5 & 5-12 year olds)
- ADA accessible walkway

History:

2008:

- This property was obtained by the City through the parkland dedication requirements for the Indian Hills 6th Addition subdivision.

2014:

- Mr. Bill Parks donated \$40,000 toward the purchase of a lot and the City paid \$7,500 to cover the difference for the lot.
- An additional lot was dedicated by the Thompson family via parkland dedication, bringing about the present 1.2 acre park.
- City Council approved the name of Indian Hills Park

2017:

- Mr. Bill Parks donated \$25,000 towards new play structures for the park.
- June – Playground and ADA accessible pathway added

2018:

- August 21- The parks grand opening took place.
