

## LOLA CLYDE PARK

### Northeast Corner of North Polk Extension & Rodeo Drive

*5.1 Acres*

#### **Description:**

Located at the Northeast corner of North Polk Extension and Rodeo Drive, this open space area looks toward development.



#### **History:**

1996:

- The City Council approved the purchase of this parcel of land in May, 1996 for \$58,850 from Skyler Schlueter. As part of the purchase agreement, the property would be named Lola Clyde Park after Schlueter's grandmother, Lola Clyde.

2005:

- Palouse Clearwater Environmental Institute teamed up with the City to reconstruct Hogg Creek into the meandering stream it is today.

2006:

- A pedestrian bridge was constructed across the creek by University of Idaho engineering students.

2018:

- August 29- Lola Clyde Park sign dedication took place.



2019:

- Summer- Turf and irrigation was installed.
- Construction of the inclusive and ADA accessible playground for ages 2-12.
