

TRIANGLE PARK

Description:

If you are looking for a place to bring the family, play Frisbee, or just relax in the sun, then this bright triangle of green grass in a somewhat secluded section of town is the place for you.

History:

1957:

- When surrounding subdivision was platted, 1.75 acres of land was set aside for a park. The land was undeveloped for next 18 years.



1975:

- July 15 – City broke ground and began construction of East Gate Park.
- With the approval of the 1975 budget, \$7,025 was set aside to construct a small triangle shaped park, which became East Gate Park.

1976:

- September – East Gate Park was completed.

2009:

- Summer of 2009, the old unsafe playground equipment was removed and replaced with new equipment.

2017:

- Drinking fountain, bottle filler, and dog drinking fountain was installed.

2018:

- November 13- East Gate Park was renamed Triangle Park after Ginny Saunders, 10 years old of Moscow, sent a letter to City Council requesting the name change.
