

8TH STREET RESERVOIR PARK

South of 8th Street past Lynn Street

0.75 Acres

Description:

Reservoir Park can be accessed from 8th street just east of Lynn Street. The pathway and grassy areas around the reservoir provide a wonderful location to relax and enjoy a peaceful day.



Amenities:

- Two Million Gallon Water Reservoir
- Open Grassy Areas with Minimal Parking

History:

1967:

- December 21 – The City purchases the current site of the 8th Street Reservoir Park water tank for \$8,700. The estimated cost of the 32-foot reservoir was approximately \$164,000.

1968:

- The water reservoir at 8th Street Reservoir Park was built by the City of Moscow's Water Department. From 1968 until 1998, the City of Moscow's Parks and Recreation Department maintained the property that contains this water reservoir.



1998:

- The Water Department took over maintenance of the 8th Street Reservoir Park and the Vista Park and Reservoir facilities for the next six years until 2004.

2004:

- The Parks and Recreation Department resumed maintaining the 8th Street Reservoir Park facility.
