- Lights, sirens, action! Come interact with the Fleet team's display board.

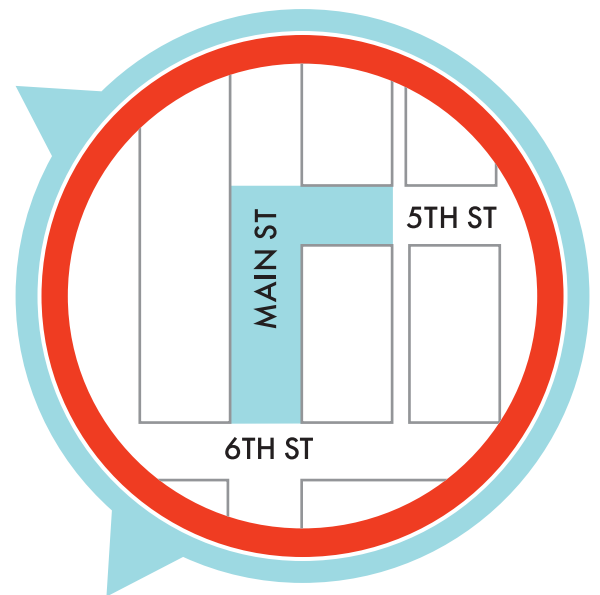

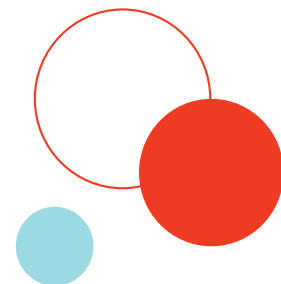

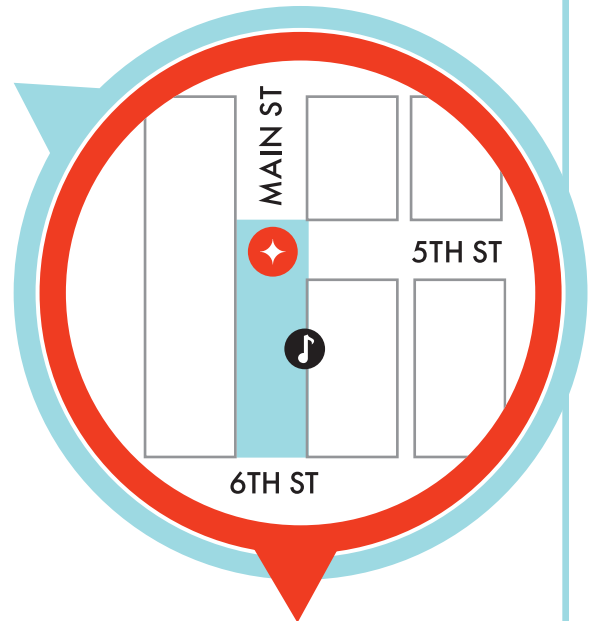
